LONDON TO HOST 2009 DAUGHTERS OF THE NILE SUPREME SESSIONS CONVENTION

One of the largest conventions in the history of our city is confirmed for London June 5 – 11, 2009.

The Daughters of the Nile Supreme Sessions Convention is a gathering of up to 2500 delegates which will use an estimated 8,600 hotel room nights and generate an estimated economic impact of \$2.2 million for London. Daughters of the Nile is an organization with 42,000 members and 148 temples throughout North America.

“London is honoured to be the host city for such a prestigious event,” says John Winston, General Manager of Tourism London.
